

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 53 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN SCOTT OGILVIE**

2 An ordinance prohibiting the harassment of pedestrians and bicyclists; containing  
3 definitions; prohibited activities; and a penalty clause.

4 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

5 **SECTION ONE: Definitions.**

6 A. "Bicyclist" means any device propelled by human power upon which a  
7 person may ride, having two tandem wheels except scooters and similar  
8 devices.

9 B. "Pedestrian" means

10 (a) A person who is on foot; or

11 (b) A person who is using any means of conveyance propelled by human power  
12 other than a bicycle; or

13 (c) A person who is using an electric personal assistive mobility device; or

14 (d) A person who is operating a self-propelled wheelchair, motorized tricycle, or  
15 motorized quadricycle to act as a pedestrian and, by reason of physical disability, is  
16 otherwise restricted in movement as or unable to move about on foot.

17 **SECTION TWO: Prohibiting the harassment of pedestrians and bicyclists.**

18 A person commits the offense of harassment of a pedestrian or bicyclist if the person:

19 (1) Throws an object or directs a projectile at or in the direction of any person riding a  
20 bicycle, walking, running or operating a wheelchair for the purpose of frightening,  
21 disturbing or injuring the person; or

22 (2) Threatens any person riding a bicycle, walking, running or operating a wheelchair for  
23 the purpose of frightening or disturbing that person; or

24 (3) Knowingly places a person riding a bicycle, walking, running or operating a

1 wheelchair in apprehension of immediate physical injury; or  
2 (4) Knowingly engages in conduct that creates a risk of death or serious physical injury to  
3 a person riding a bicycle, walking, running or operating a wheelchair.

4 **SECTION THREE. Penalty Clause.**

5 Any person who violates the provisions of this chapter shall be subject to of a fine of not  
6 less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or a  
7 term of imprisonment not more than ninety (90) days or both a fine and term of  
8 imprisonment.
