ELIGIBLE USE OF FUNDS - - -

Infrastructure Projects



- At least 70 percent but not more than 90 percent of funds allocated to these projects
- Sidewalks, traffic calming, speed reduction, pedestrian & bicycle crossings, on/off street bike facilities and parking
- Pedestrian facilities
- Traffic diversion

Behavioral Projects

- At least 10 percent but not more than 30 percent of funds allocated to these projects
- Public awareness campaigns and outreach to press and community leaders
- Traffic education and enforcement in the vicinity of schools
- Student education on pedestrian & bicycle safety, health and the environment
- Training for SRTS volunteers & managers
